Fall 2017 Study Programs

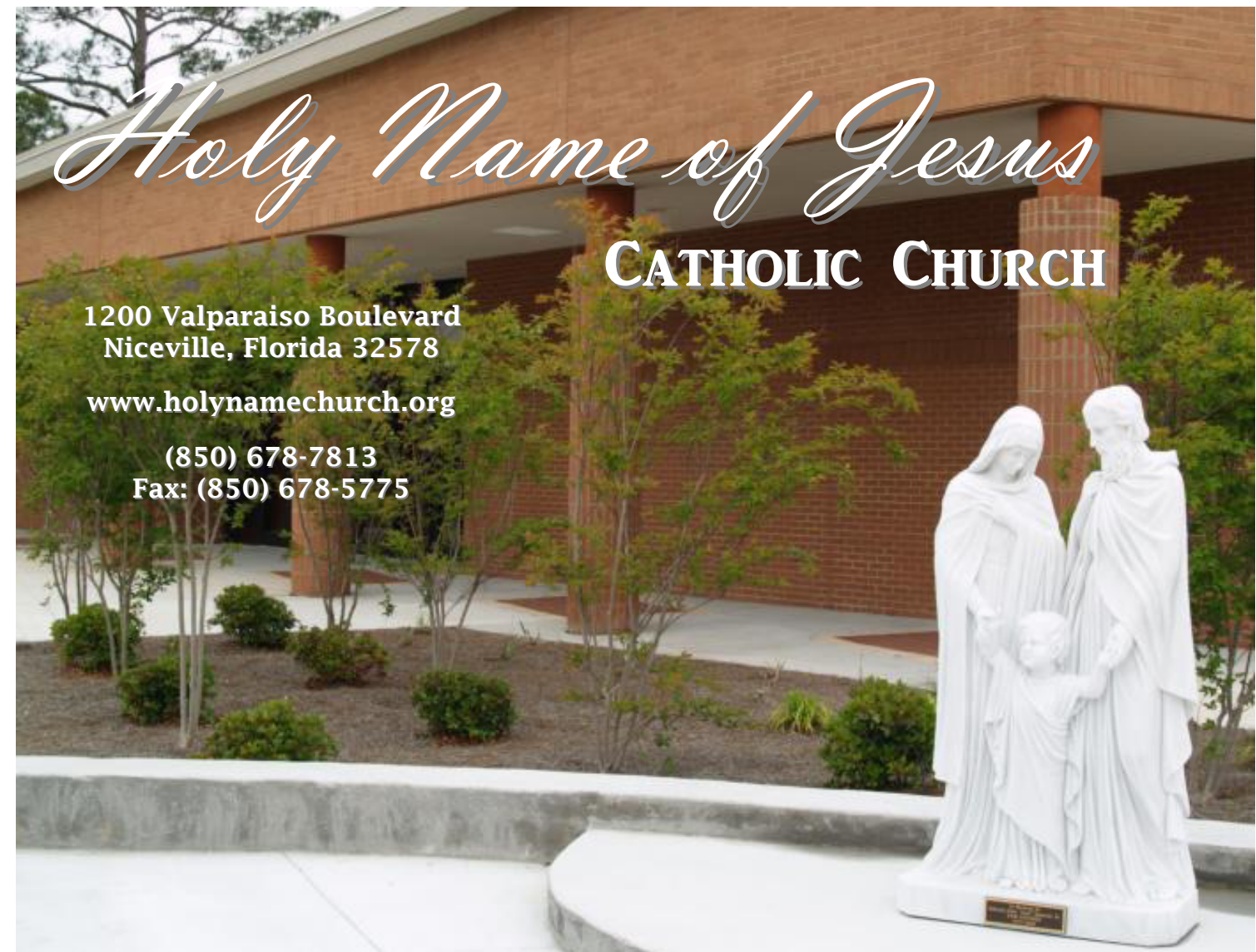
Looking to be inspired to live your faith more fully by gaining deeper Scriptural insight? Hoping that you can make positive changes with prayer, meditation, and group discussion?
