## RUMMAGE SALE IS COMING

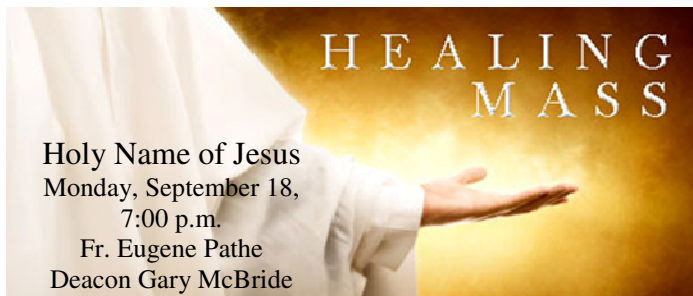
